Space is limited, and therefore entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Each school is limited to two teams in each event. ***Players may only play for the school they attend.***

Format	Five-round Swiss system (teams play five matches, with one possible bye)
Rounds	The first round will begin at 9:30 a.m. Additional rounds will begin at approximately 11:00 a.m., 1:00 p.m., 2:30 pm, and 4:30 p.m.
Matches	Four players from each team will play in each match.
Time Control	The time control will be one hour for the game. After one hour, the game will be completed using a chess clock, with each player having 15 minutes to complete the game. Chess clocks may be used for some matches, with a time control of 45 minutes per player for the game.
Teams	Each team will consist of four players and up to two spares. Any four team members may play in a given match. Players must be attending their school to be eligible to play – players may not play for a different school.
Entry fee	\$25 per team. This fee includes spares.
Prizes	The top 6 teams will qualify to play in the Elementary School Finals, to be held at St. George's Senior School on February 22, 2003.
Equipment	Please bring chess clocks if possible. Sets, boards and scoresheets will be provided.
Food	Food, including lunch, will be available on site.

The **Secondary School Championship** (grades 8-12), open to all secondary schools in British Columbia.

Rounds	The first round will begin at 9:30 a.m. Additional rounds will begin at approximately 11:00 a.m., 1:00 p.m., 2:30 pm, and 4:30 p.m.
Matches	Four players from each team will play in each match.
Time Control	The time control will be one hour for the game. After one hour, the game will be completed using a chess clock, with each player having 15 minutes to complete the game. Chess clocks may be used for some matches, with a time control of 45 minutes per player for the game.
Teams	Each team will consist of four players and up to two spares. Any four team members may play in a given match. Players must be attending their school to be eligible to play – players may not play for a different school.
